Fatz's SR20DET conversion on an R31 skyline 4 door

the arms to make it to the Silvia front control arm and hub assembly. So option is to modify the steering arms or go for the Silvia
steering rack (I took the last option

Silvia cross member needed to be modified to fit so out she came form her temporary resting place!

Rack was out as was the cross member.

Project came to an end about now because I just got the shit that everything didn't fit properly!



Look at all that space.. can't wait to get her in I kept the clutch slave and master but was prepared to swap it to Silvia if need be Modifying the cross member



Just mig welded on some metal ppe that a workshop uses for side intrusion bars the re drill the hole so she slots on One more



Ready for some drilling

Have to shorten the searing shaft by about one inch to fit the new rack! Due to it being further reaward than standard. However notice that even though the cross member is further back the front control arm suspension mounting is in the standard skyline position so the wheel comes out the right spot in the centre still! Gold we love you Nissan



Here we go s13 cross member and s13 steering rack.. in she goes



Make the s13 front suspension fit= too easy.. bolts straight in with kei office coil overs to give a firm ride and adjustable suspension Steering rack was 90 bux!

Have a look at that you don't see many r31 4 door with front struts like that



Ready for an engine now!



Someone bought the gearbox from the rb30 for 250 so I was happy with that so price update! (car 1000, starter motor 170, apprentice 50, power steering rack 90, sold motor for 250 TOTAL\$1040)



Engine hoist carked it so I bought the super cheap block and tackle... 99 bux!!!



Problem was I had to get the car over to the engine to get it in now!! This is when I found out that the person who pulled apart the engine gearbox didn't give me all the bolts so it had to just put the engine in at first

More dodgy wiring!!!! I'm starting to hate the previous owner!!!




Need to get a gearbox cross member to fit
